Introducing Jeff and Connie Doughty!

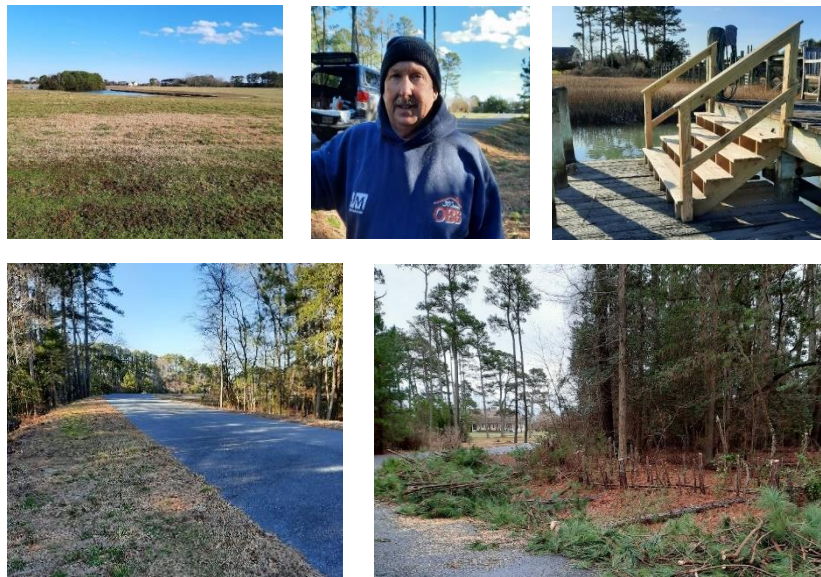
